

WayPoint Resources BUY LOCAL POLICY

Local business is defined as any business that owns, operates out of, or leases a building within Central lowa and uses the building for the conduct of actual business operations within the state of lowa.

This policy is adopted to give some preference to businesses that pay taxes and participate in our community. Preference should not be so great that it imposes unacceptable costs on WayPoint Resources (WPR). The cost must be carefully weighed in relation to the benefits received.

It is the policy of WPR to consider purchasing goods or services from local businesses when the cost and other considerations are relatively equal. The cost is relatively equal when the cost difference is no greater than 10% of the higher quote. Other considerations include but are not limited to, vendor reputation in the community, past WPR experience with the vendor, and timeliness of delivery of goods or services.
